Ph.D. Program Regulations

Doctor of Philosophy in Academic Publishing

Article 1 – Program Objectives

The Ph.D. in Academic Publishing is designed to train highly qualified professionals in the field of scholarly publishing, academic communication, and the management of scientific journals and editorial projects. The program promotes advanced knowledge and skills in designing, editing, evaluating, and disseminating academic research according to international standards.

Article 2 – Duration and Structure

- The program has a **duration of 12 months** and awards **60 ECTS credits**.
 - It is delivered **entirely online**, through a combination of synchronous (live) and asynchronous (recorded) learning.
 - The curriculum includes **theoretical modules**, **research activities**, and the **final doctoral thesis**.
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Article 3 – Admission Requirements

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- A Master's degree or equivalent (EQF level 7 or higher);
- Updated Curriculum Vitae;
- Motivation letter and preliminary research proposal;
- Minimum English proficiency level B2 (CEFR scale).

Applications are evaluated by the **Academic Committee**, which may schedule an interview with selected candidates.
